Dear Parents/Carers,

Each time Jack returns to class, we will be encouraging the children to share their diary entries. Some children might feel confident enough to stand up in front of the class and share Jack's diary, whereas others might prefer to sit at a table with 3 or 4 children at a time. Please could you ensure that your child returns Jack to school so that another child can take him home.
